Privacy Policy - Website

We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our website visitors; this policy sets out how we treat your personal information. Our website uses cookies. In compliance with recent changes in EU law, we have updated this policy to reflect that cookies are used on our website. By using our website and agreeing to this policy, you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy.

Who We Are

In terms of the relevant General Data Protection Regulation 2018, the Data Controller is: St Mary's School, Calne, a company limited by guarantee. Registered number 00235572. Registered Charity 309482.

St Margaret's Preparatory School is an operational subsidiary of St Mary's School, Calne and operates within that entity's policy frameworks, including Data Protection and Privacy.

Purpose of this Privacy Policy

This policy is intended to provide information about how the school will use personal data about individuals. This information is provided because General Data Protection Regulation 2018 gives individuals rights to understand how their data is used. You are encouraged to read this Policy and understand the school's obligations to users of this website, as well as its wider community.

What information do we collect?

We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal data:

- Information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this website, such as IP address, location, browser type, referral source, length of visit and number of page views;
- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of registering with us.
- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of subscribing to our website services, email notifications and/or newsletters.
- Any other information that you choose to send to us.

Cookies

We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a text file sent by a web server to a web browser, and stored by the browser. The text file is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server, this enables the web server to identify and track the web browser.

We may use the information we obtain from the cookie in the administration of this website, to improve the website's usability and increase security. We may also use that information to recognise your computer when you visit our website, and to personalise our website for you.

We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of our website. Google Analytics generate statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to using our website is used to create reports about the use of our website; Google will store this information. You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies you may not be able to access all parts of our website. Using personal data

Personal data submitted on this website will be used for the purposes specified in this privacy policy or in relevant parts of the website.

We may use your personal information to:

- Administer the website.
- Improve your browsing experience.

- Send you general (non-marketing) communications.
- Send you email notifications which you have specifically requested.
- Send to you marketing communications relating to the school which we think may be of interest to you by post or, where you have specifically consented to this, by email or similar technology (you can inform us at any time if you no longer desire marketing communications to be sent to you).
- Provide third parties with statistical information about our users, but this information will not be used to identify any individual user.
- Deal with enquiries and complaints made by or about you relating to the website.

We will not without your express consent provide your personal information to any third parties for the purpose of direct marketing.

Other disclosures

In addition to the disclosures reasonably necessary for the purposes identified elsewhere in this Privacy Policy, we may disclose information about you:

- To the extent that we are required to do so by law.
- In connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings.
- In order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk).
- To the purchaser (or prospective purchaser) of any business or asset which we are (or are contemplating) selling.
- Except as provided in this Privacy Policy, we will not provide your information to third parties.

Security of your Personal Data

We will take reasonable technical and organisational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. We will store all the personal information you provide on our secure servers. All electronic transactions you make to or receive from us will be encrypted using SSL technology. Of course, data transmission over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet. You are responsible for keeping your password and user details confidential. We will not ask you for you log-on details.

Your Rights

You may instruct us to provide you with any personal information we hold about you.
